Nihao! We are proud to offer to Springer students the Mandarin Chinese after school program, taught by Yan Shi (a Springer parent!) for 1st through 4th grade. This is our second session this year.

China's importance in the global economy makes Mandarin Chinese a critical language to learn for now and the future. Your child will benefit significantly in the increasingly competitive global economy by developing Mandarin Chinese language skills.

The program has been specifically developed for children by Yan Shi, a native speaker with teaching credentials in early childhood development. Through a variety of fun games, singing, children's poems, and crafts, the children develop vocabulary, conversation and recognition of Chinese symbols. This session will include role playing to practice conversation (i.e. at a restaurant, at the airport, etc.)
