



Interested in fun, innovative, and challenging math problems?

Springer will host an after school Math Olympic team to:

- promote enthusiasm and a love for Mathematics
- leverage and reinforce Mathematical concepts and problem solving strategies
- increase Mathematical intuition, creativity, and ingenuity
- provide for the satisfaction and enjoyment of meeting challenges

We will meet Fridays September 28th through May 3rd to review problem solving strategies and problems. Friday September 28th will be a free introductory preview session. This year there will be two classes, by grade and contest level. Students in Grades 4 and 5 will participate in the Math Olympiad Elementary School contest and older students will participate in the Math Olympiad Middle School contest. During the earlier session, Middle School participants have *Super Silent Study* (SSS) time for doing that week's Math Olympiad homework. Students may also bring a book or other homework to work quietly on their own. Due to district requirements, both Elementary School and Middle School students must be in the classroom (SSS required).

- Elementary School, after school 2:50 to 3:30
- Middle School, after school to 4:15 (SSS through 3:30, Math Olympiad 3:35 to 4:15)

Registration is \$420 for 24 sessions (September 28th through May 3rd with holidays generally following the school district calendar) including Math Olympiad contest preparation materials, homework, and answer keys. Once a month from November to March, students will participate in the worldwide Math Olympiad contest at Springer. Students will participate in an additional contest after the Math Olympiad contest is complete. At the end of the year, certificates and awards will be given for individual and team participation and achievement.

Math Marines – students will solve challenging problems and compete against older students in a worldwide contest. To prepare, the expectation is for students to focus on math during class time, to give best efforts and turn in homework each week.
